REPRESENTATIVE FROM AVON AND SOMERSET CONSTABULARY

PC Amanda Thomas and PCSO Leanne Edwards from Avon and Somerset Constabulary presented the Committee with an overview of the current policing situation in the one team and some of the prevalent issues. In response to a question regarding begging in the Town Centre, PC Thomas explained that evidence was required that the person allegedly begging was asking for money so that action could be taken.
