6. LITTER BIN – SHERBORNE ROAD

Earlier this month, the Promotions and Activities Committee considered a report on the work that has been undertaken to date and that planned as part of the Yeovil Town Centre Audit Project.

Arising from the discussion, it was suggested that an additional litter bin be provided just outside the Town Centre - in the vicinity of the junction of Reckleford and Sherborne Road – to assist with the disposal of waste arising from users of the nearby takeaways, and has referred the matter to this Committee for further consideration.

The District Council has been consulted on the proposal and would be happy to install and empty the bin, the supply of which will cost approximately £450.

There is £640 remaining in the Committee’s Litter Bin budget, and Members are **RECOMMENDED** to consider using part of this budget to meet the costs of implementing this suggestion.

7. **TRAFFIC ISLAND WITH SOLAR POWERED “KEEP LEFT” BOLLARD FOR SUNNINGDALE ROAD/GREENHILL ROAD**

Members will recall that the Town Council agreed to support this Committee’s bid for the implementation of a new safety initiative at the junction of Sunningdale Road and Greenhill Road.

The planned works involve the construction of a new traffic island, which will act as a pedestrian refuge and include illuminated solar powered “keep left” bollards as shown on the attached plan at page 6.

The new island and nearby footways will include dropped kerbs and tactile pavers to make the new structure fully accessible.

The County Council has been commissioned to undertake the work, including the necessary design and construction. It is estimated that the total cost will be £11,000.

The costs involved will be met from the New Initiatives Fund and will be offset by a contribution of £1,000 from Cllr Tony Lock who has agreed to allocate part of his County Councillor delegated health and well-being budget towards the project.

It is anticipated that the work will be carried out in the next two months.

The Committee is **RECOMMENDED** to note the matter.

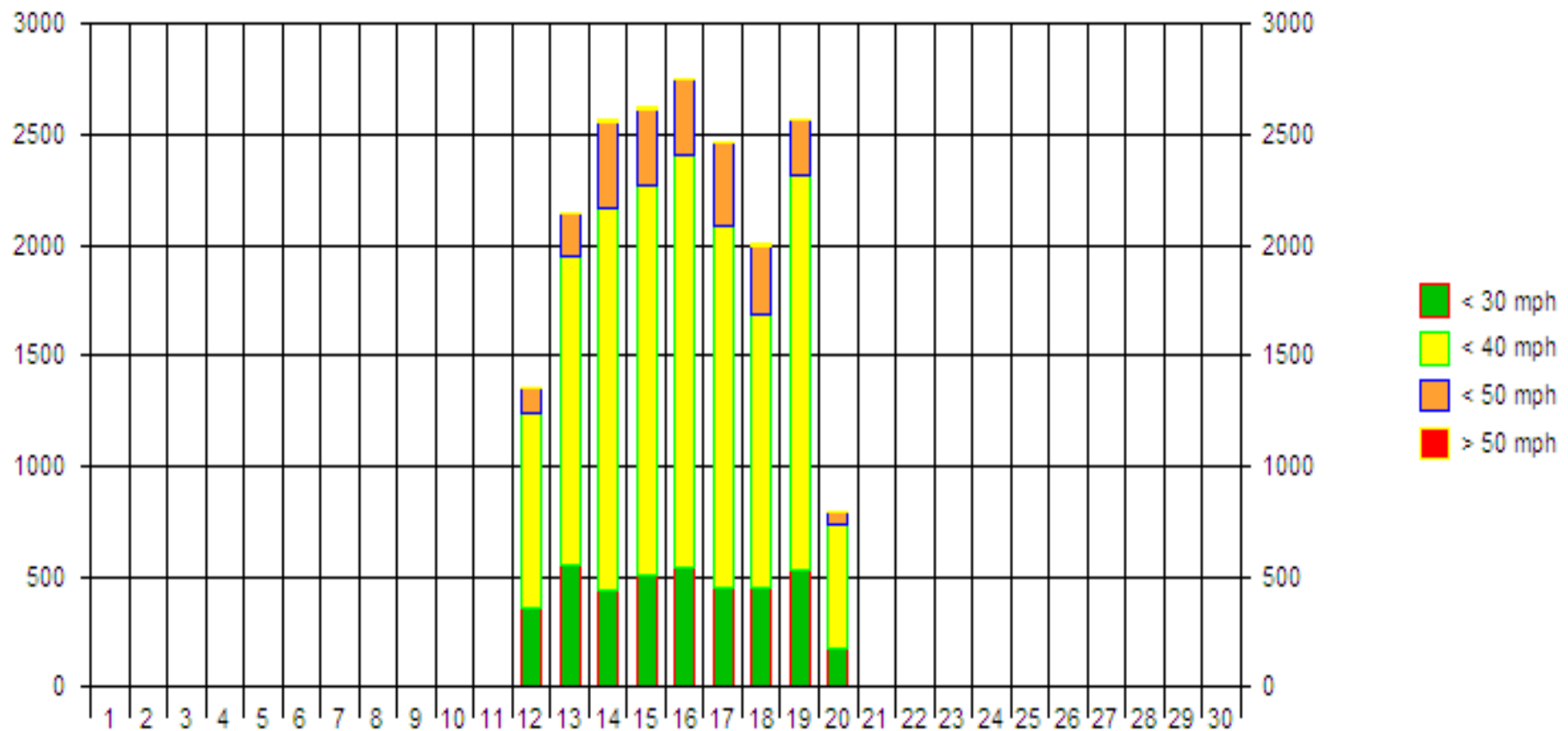
