Community Warden (Patrol & Support) - This role focuses on patrolling Yeovil Town Council areas (parks, open spaces, facilities), Checking that places are clean, safe, and in good condition, supporting vulnerable or isolated residents, encouraging positive behaviour in the community, Reporting problems so they can be fixed quickly

Community Warden (Community & Engagement) - This role focuses on working with local volunteers, helping community groups and projects, encouraging residents to get involved in community events, supporting local activities that bring people together, building strong links between the council and local people

Both roles include some evening and weekend work (depending on events and busy times), working as part of a friendly and supportive team, being flexible and willing to help where needed, talking to people, spending lots of time outdoors and in local community spaces
